

# Oakton Professor Is Listed In Art Review

Robert Stanley, a Des Plaines resident and a professor of Art at Oakton Community College, has been listed in *The Chicago Art Review*, an illustrated survey of Chicago museums, galleries and leading artists. It was his acrylic canvas painting, "Fossil of an End," that won Stanley this honor.

A graduate of Pratt Institute, Brooklyn, NY, Stanley works both on canvas and with computers, exhibiting cibachrome prints of his computer art. He has exhibited his collection of paintings at various art exhibitions, including Joy Horwich Gallery, Chicago, Germanow Art Gallery and Zaner Gallery, Rochester, NY, Contemporary Art Workshop, Chicago and Countryside Art Center, Arlington Hts. He has presented several computer graphic art shows at McAuley Gallery at Mount Mercy College in Cedar Rapids, IA.
