

ROBERT STANLEY '64 (ART) and his wife, Juana, live in Beverly Shores, Ind. Mirca Art Group, an international association of artists, invited Robert to be in an exhibition recognizing Malala Yousafzai in Skogas, Sweden, from Aug. 29 through Oct. 24, 2015. He writes, "Yousafzai, a young Pakistani



woman, was shot by the Taliban for going to school. She won a Nobel Peace Prize as a human rights activist for advocating for education for women. For the exhibition, I created a poster depicting Yousafzai, with references to her suffering and those who supported her, and her words, 'Let us make our future now, and let us make our dreams tomorrow's reality.'" Robert, who owns a studio in Michigan City, Ind., has exhibited art in the Chicago area since 1973. His work is in several museum collections and has been juried into national and international art shows.
